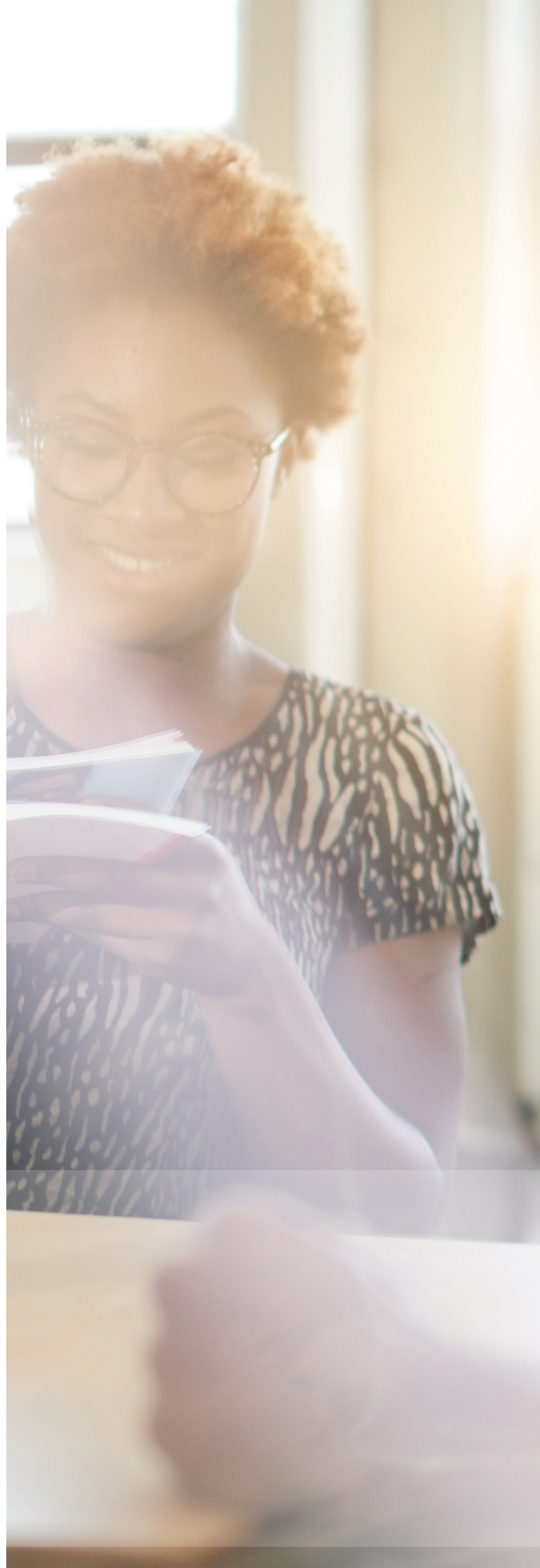

If you have a facilities-related degree and at least three years' management experience.

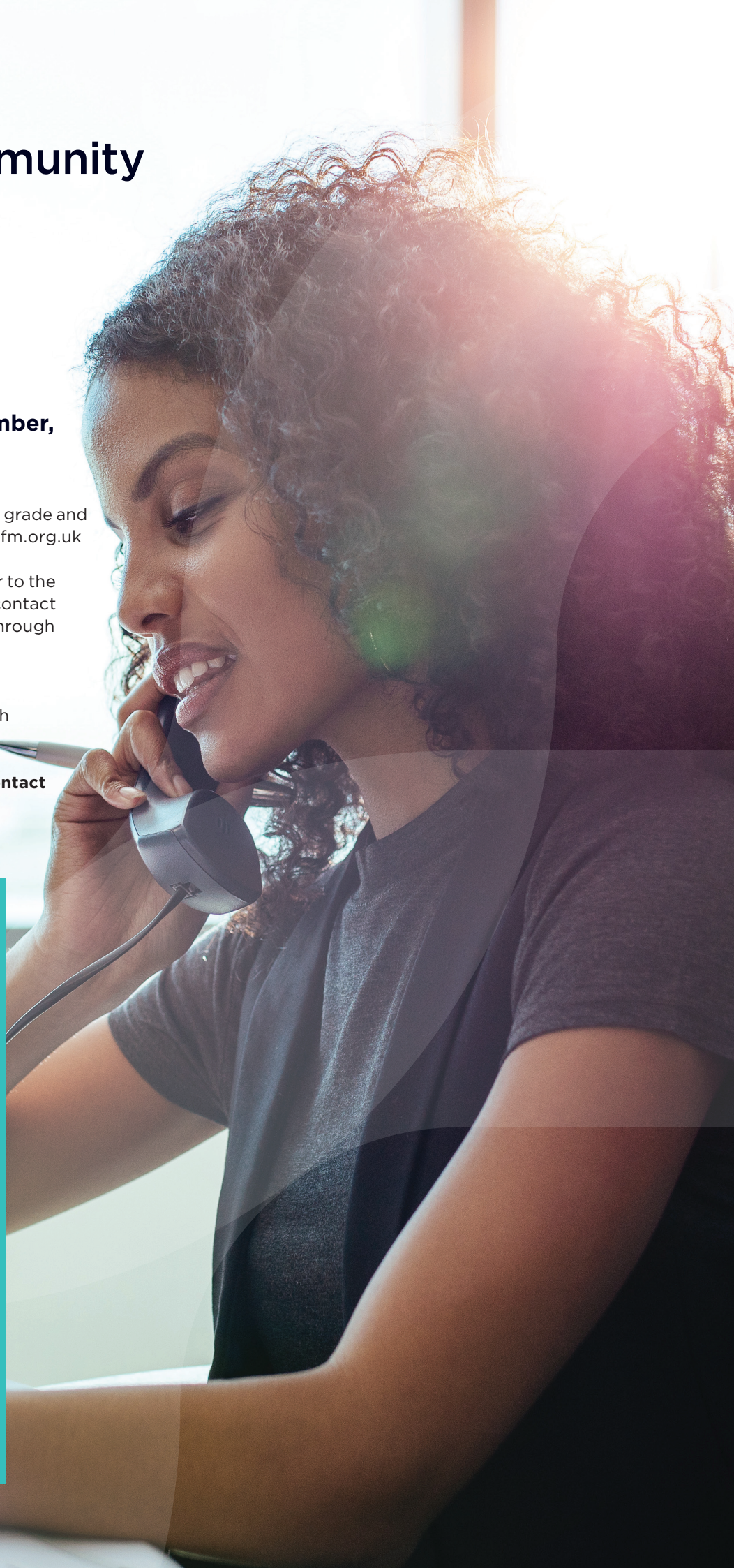
